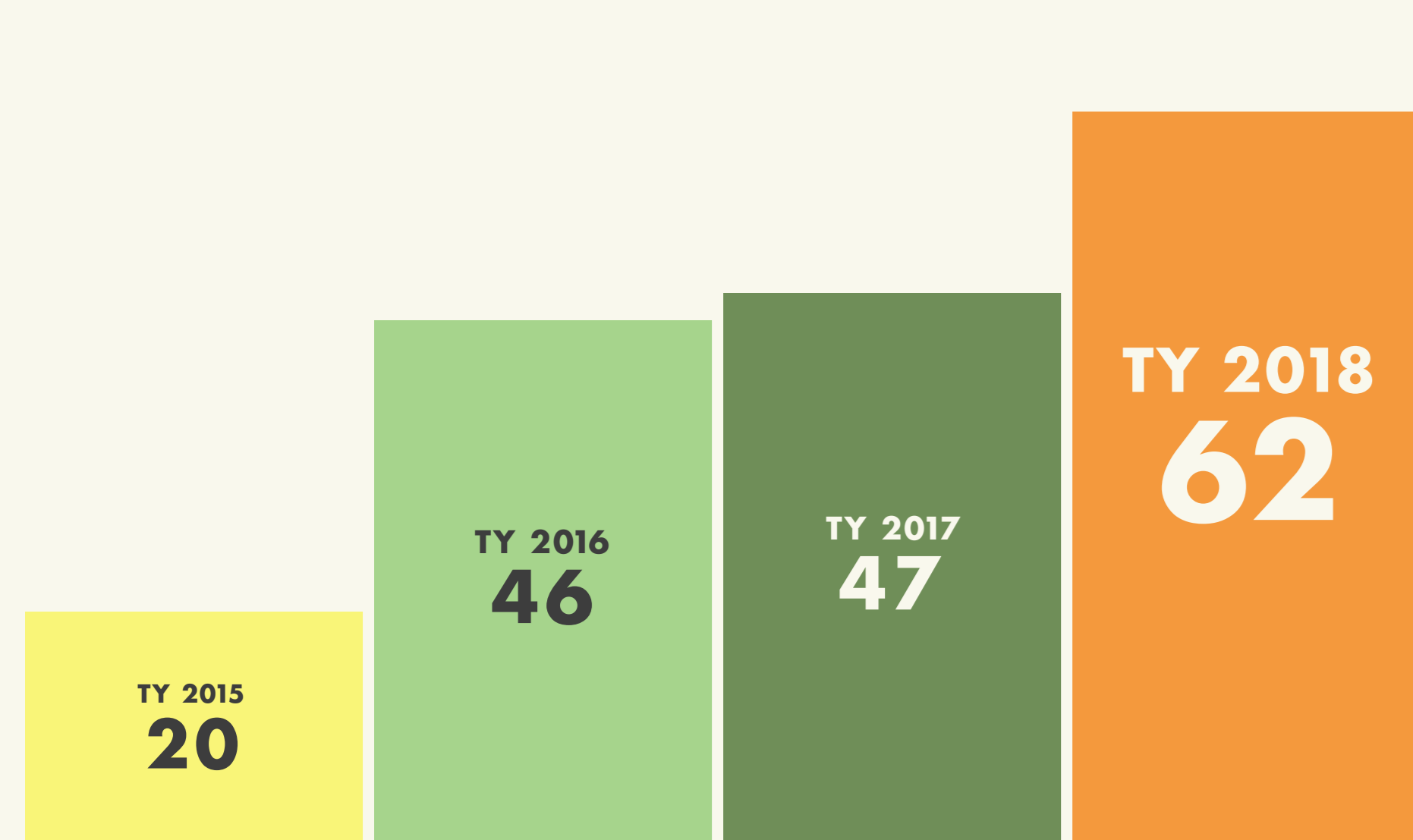

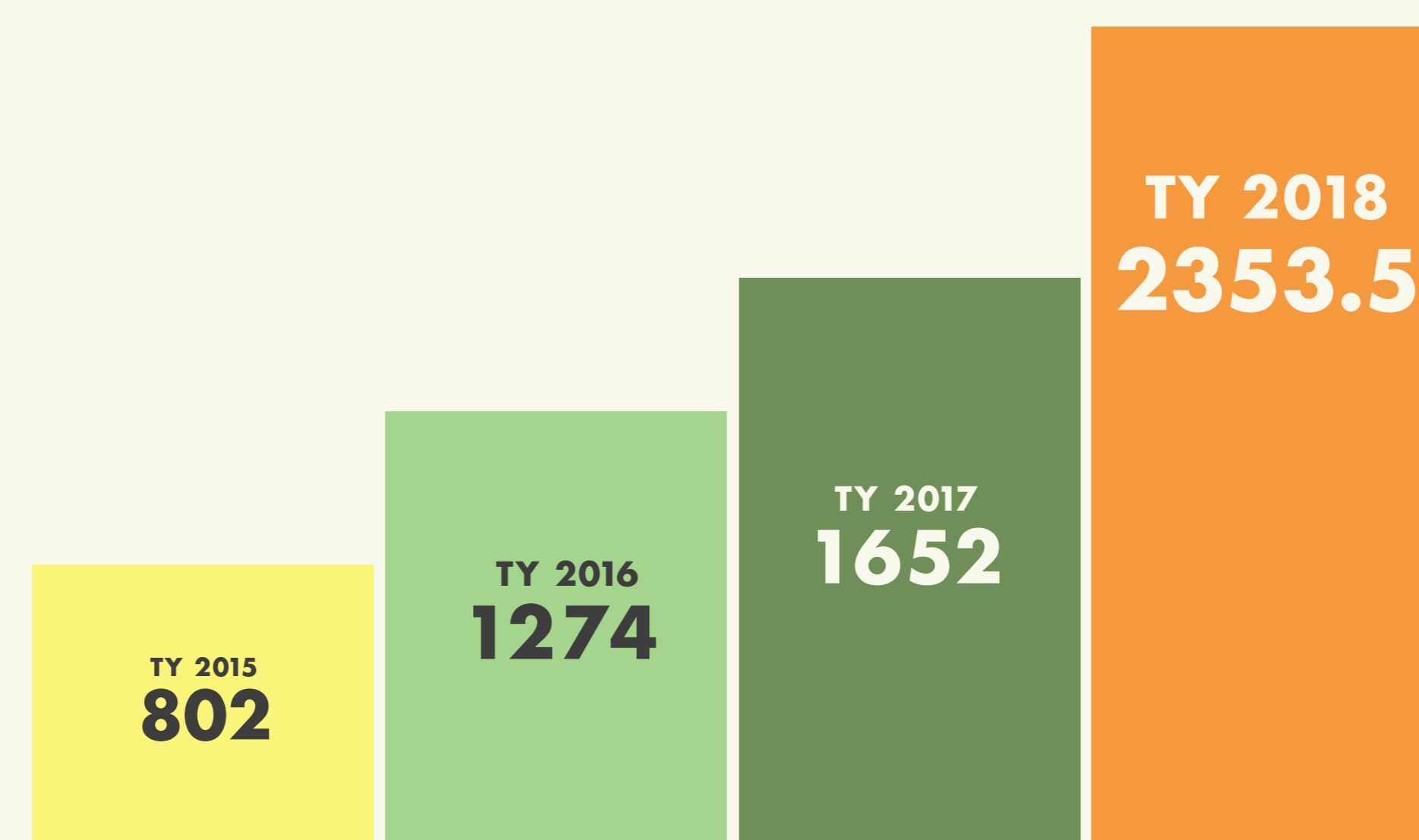
— PROGRAM INFORMATION —

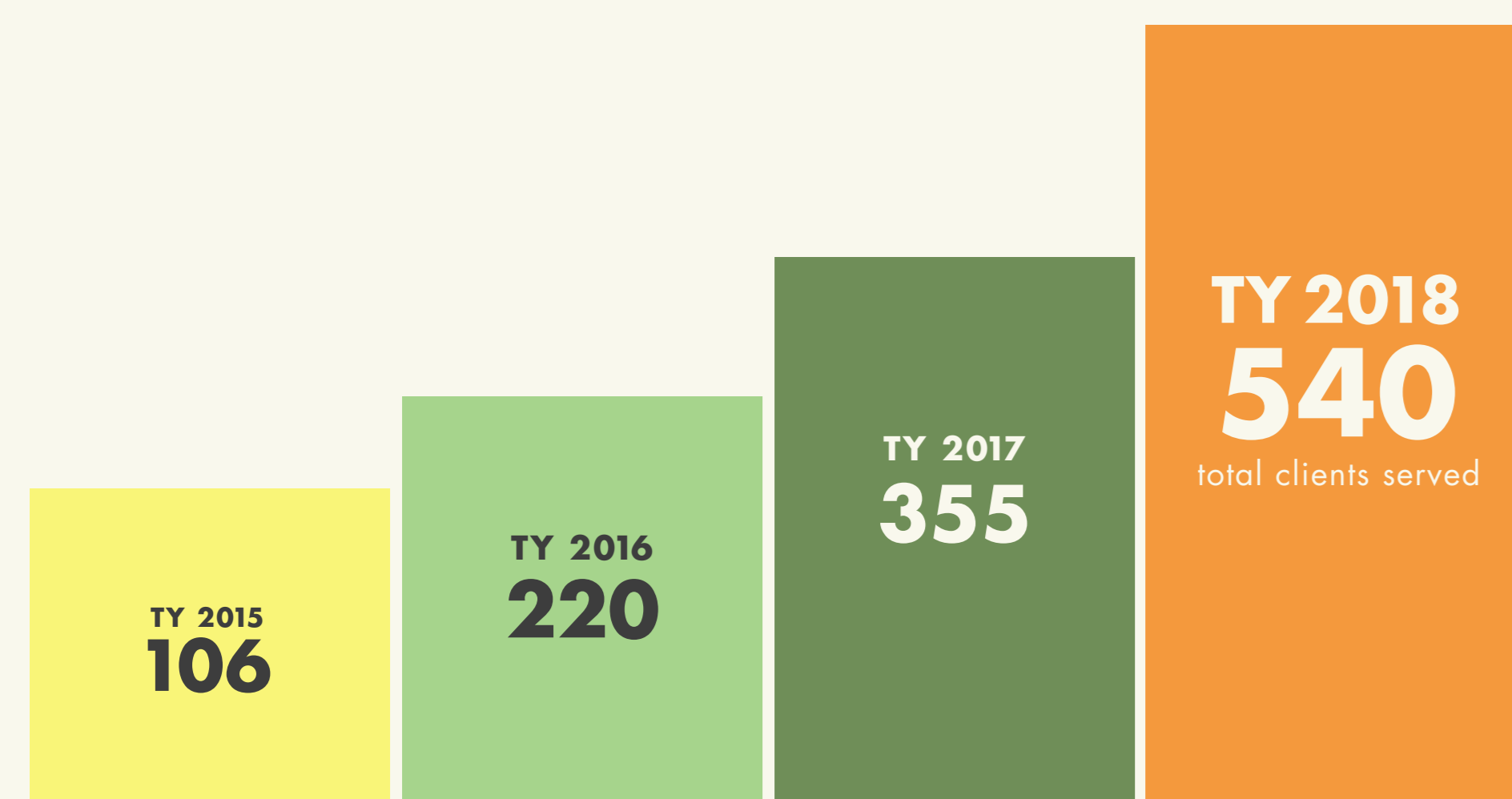

AVERAGE ADJUSTED GROSS INCOME OF CLIENTS

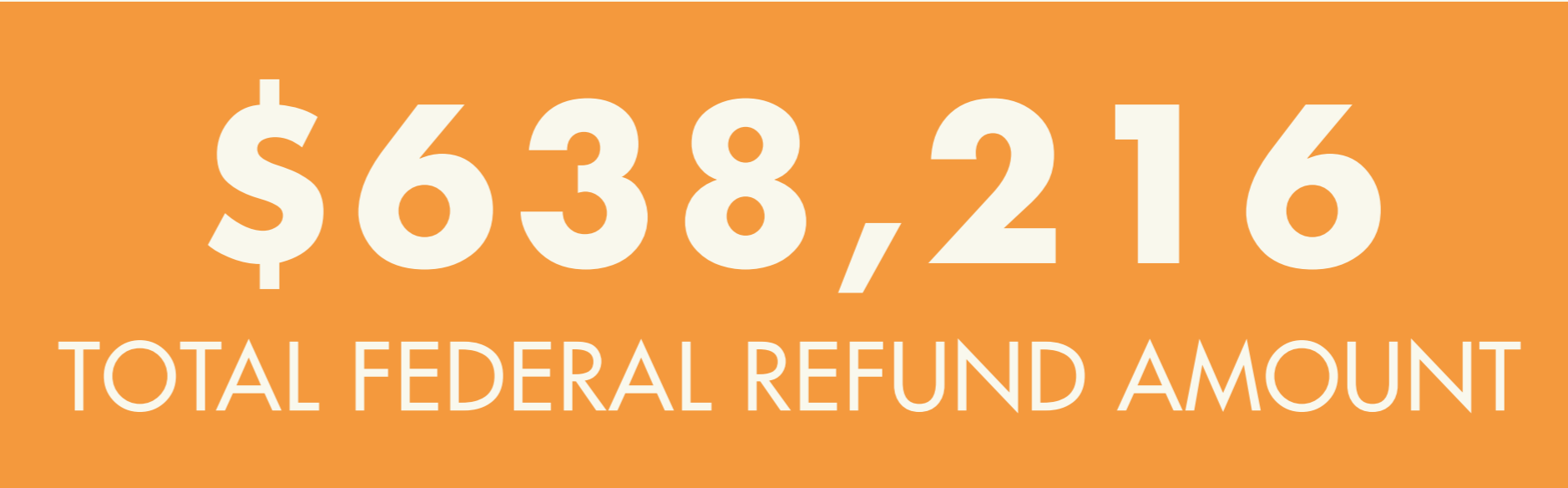

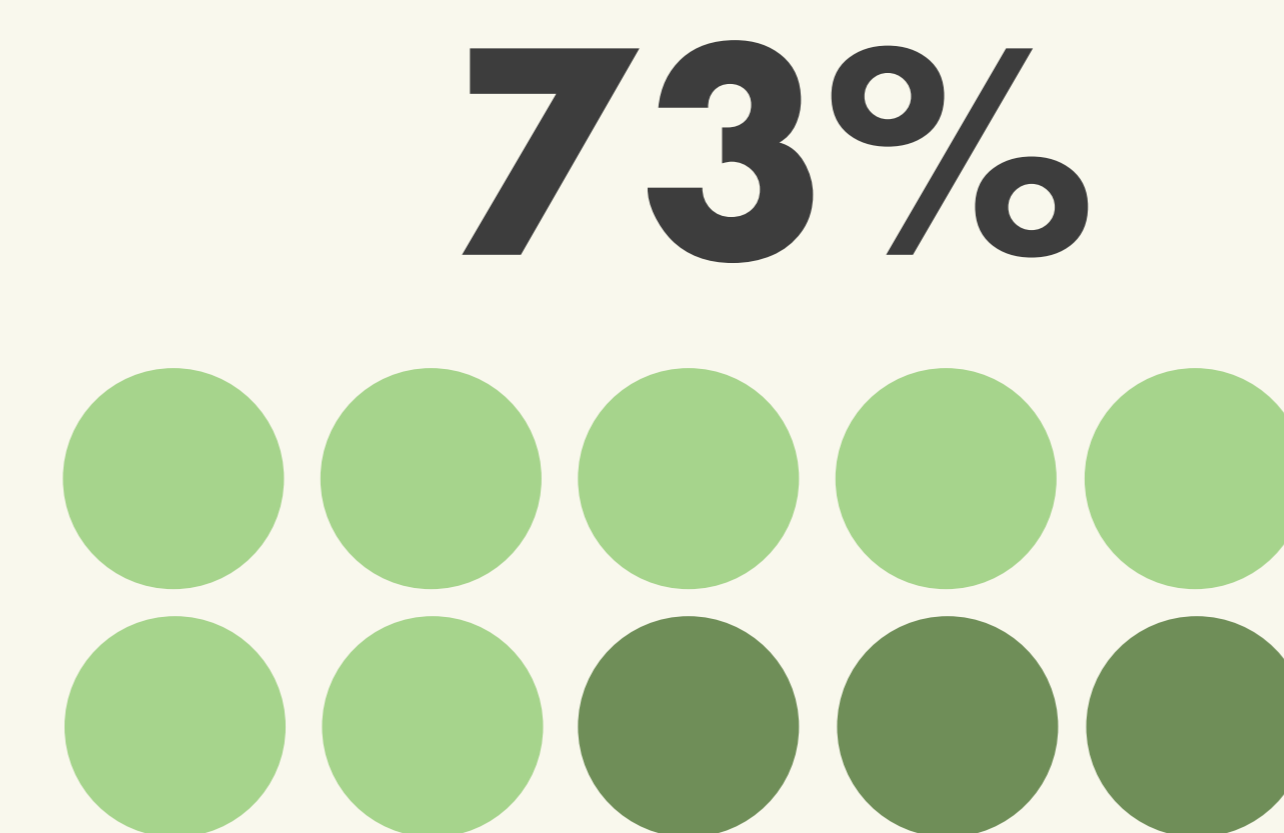

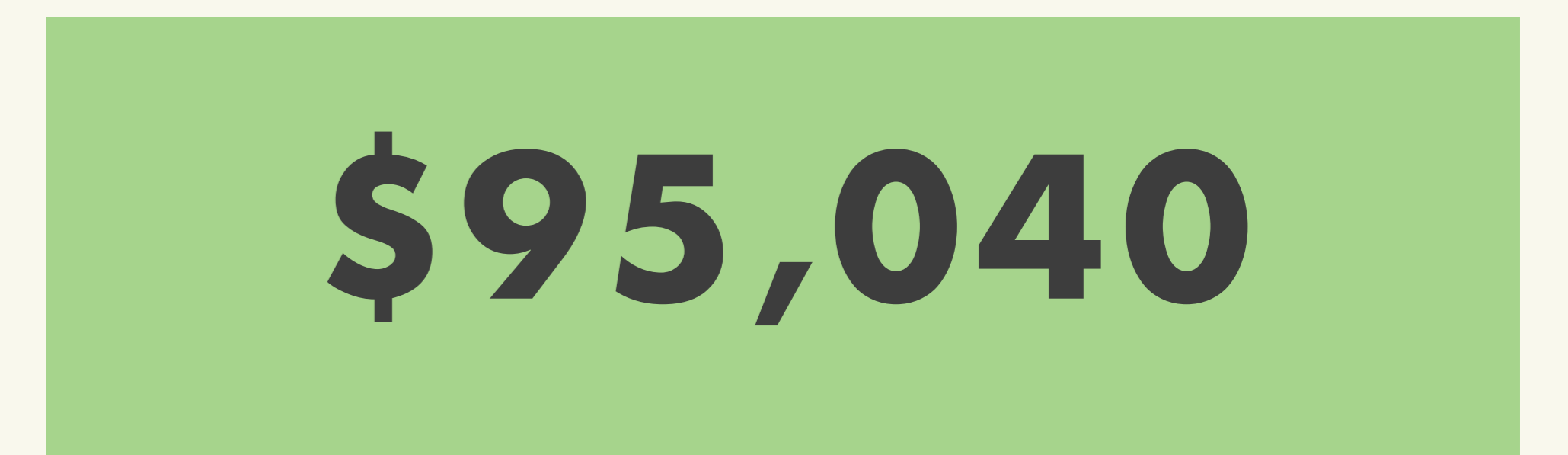
— HOW CLIENTS BENEFITED FROM THE VITA PROGRAM —



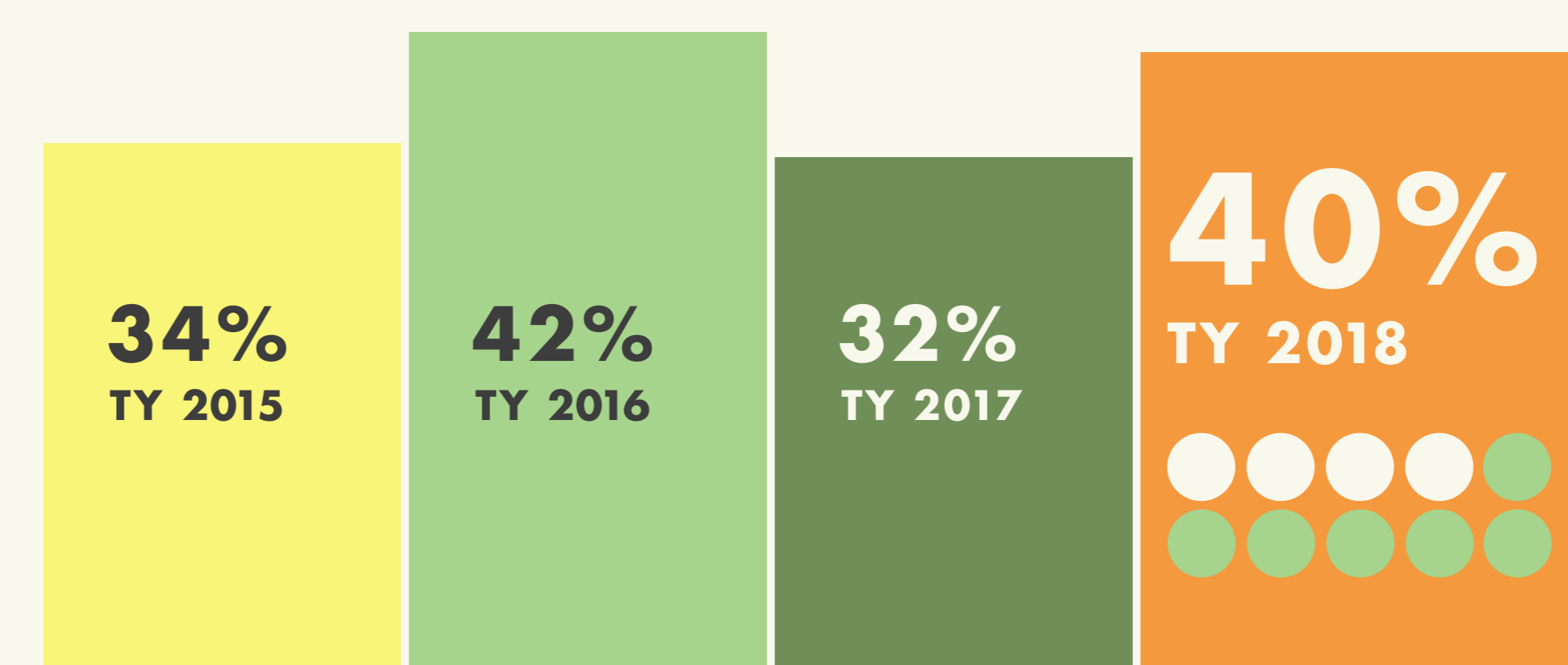
CLIENTS WHO GOT A REFUND



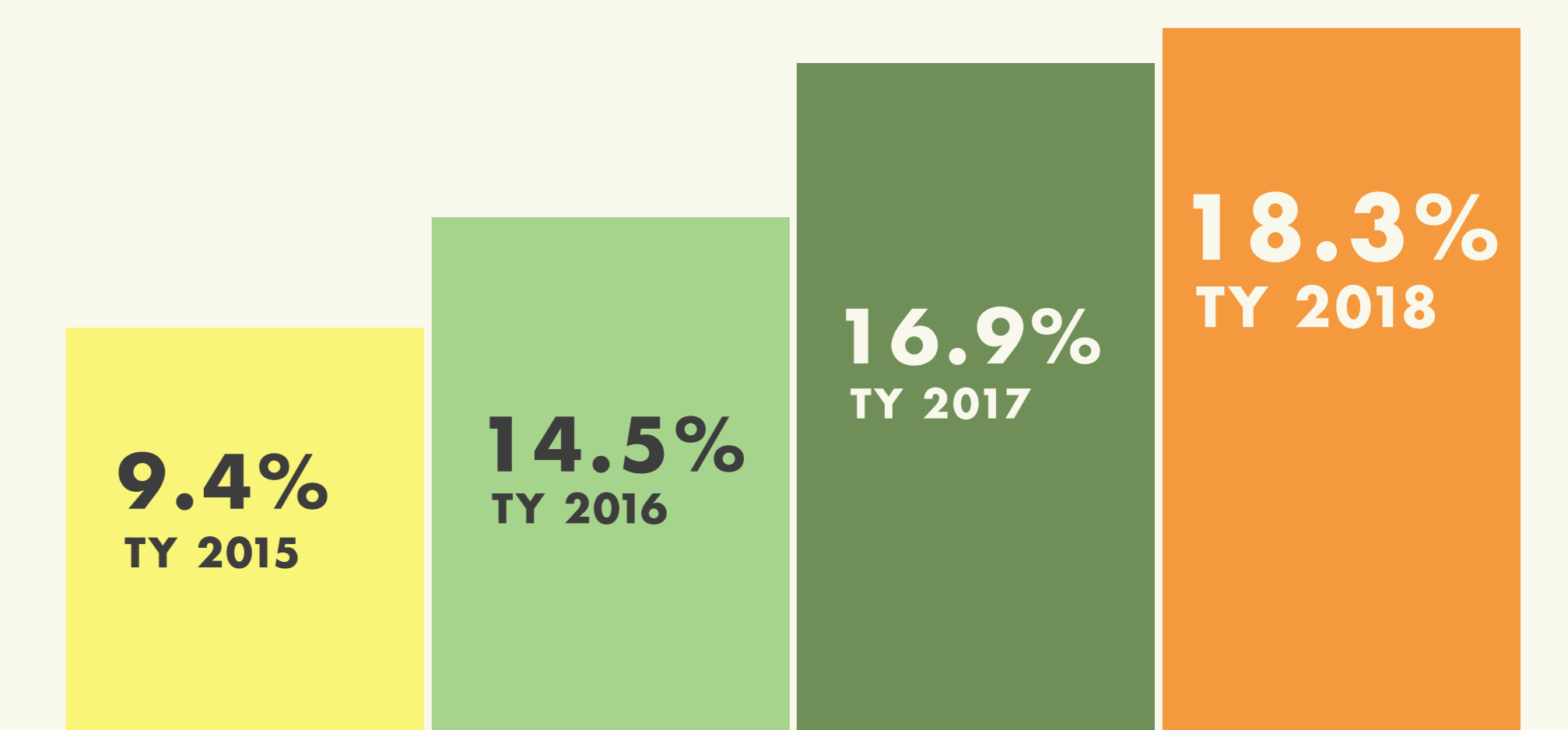
TAX PREPARATION FEES SAVED BY CLIENTS



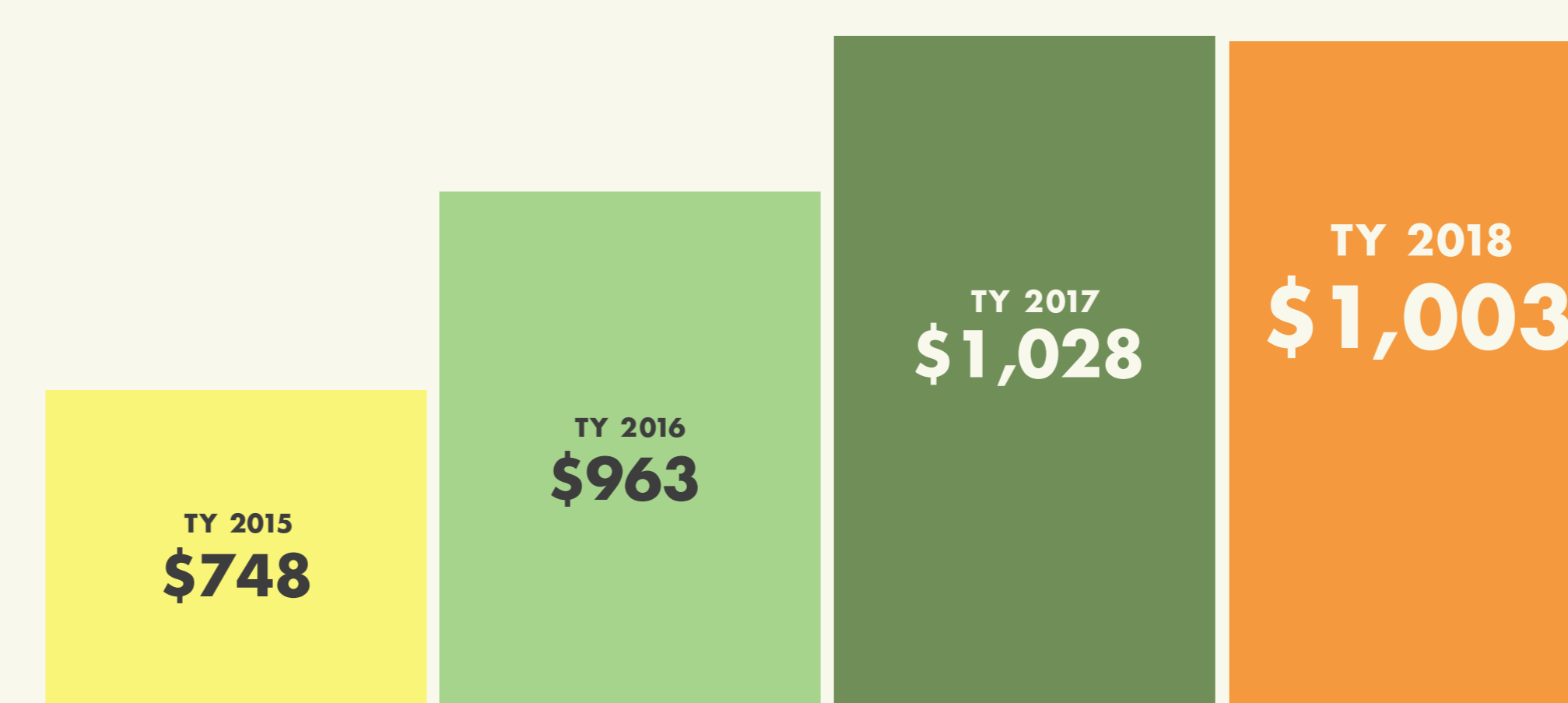
CLIENTS WITH DEPENDENTS WHO GOT CHILD TAX CREDIT



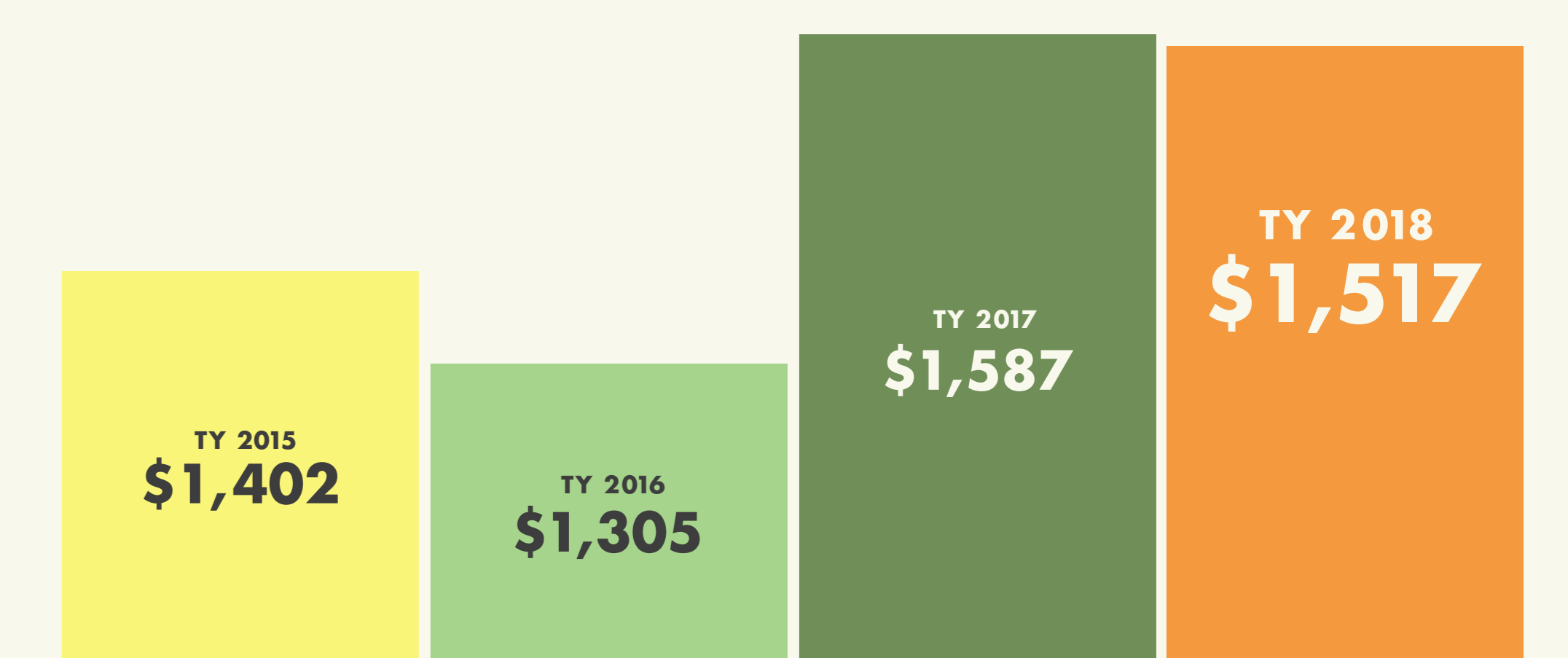
CLIENTS WHO HAD A FEDERAL BALANCE DUE
